The carnival Marshals reserve the right to refuse entry on the day if the vehicle and/or occupants are deemed unable to take part in a safe manner. Safety is paramount both to yourselves and bystanders.

Wareham Carnival Float Information recommendations

:
Make sure that the construction of the float is sufficient to withstand the stresses and strains that will be put on it during the procession Particular attention should be given to guarding moving parts and providing guards or restraints to prevent falls from floats. No leaning out over the edges of the float. Entrants shall accept and comply with the instructions of marshals with regard to route, timing, safety and ordering of the procession or individual parts of it.

All entries are encouraged to collect money during the course of the procession (buckets provided) and for it to be given to a Carnival Steward at the Recreational Ground. No collections can be made for other charities or groups but they can apply for funding via the Carnival Committee

Entries to arrive between 12.00 and 12.30pm. Judging this year is on route. The procession start is prompt at 1:00pm. No guarantee can be made that entries arriving after 12:30pm will be able to take part in the procession.

ASSMEBLY POINT

The pre registration and assembly point is by the fore court at Rapid fit (north street) which is also referred to as the south of the North Causeway. For safety reasons once the line of floats gets close to the roundabout the remainder will be asked to assemble the other side which is the road leading from the roundabout to the train station. This area is also known as north of north causeway) offering a safe grassed triangular area where all entrants not staying with their vehicles need to be in order to be safe and joyous..
